Bill Hoover Pathfinder Award

This is an Advanced Pathfinder of the Year Program for teens in 9th-12th grade. This award is above and beyond the KYTN Pathfinder of the Year award and is to challenge the teens in their service for others. Every Teen Pathfinder should be encouraged to complete these requirements. The requirements are within the reach of those who strive for them with a positive attitude all through the year.

The Pathfinder medal as worn by Bill Hoover will be awarded.

Hoover Award Requirements:

- 1. Must be a Kentucky-Tennessee Conference Pathfinder in $9^{th} 12^{th}$ grade.
- 2. Must fulfill all requirements for KYTN Pathfinder of the Year for <u>current</u> Pathfinder year.
- 3. Must participate in one 7-up Invitational activity this Pathfinder year.
- 4. Must participate in one work project (7-up, TLT activity if possible, or local club project) working at least 8 hours.
- 5. Help plan and carry out a fund raising activity, raising at least \$100 per person, and give the money to a worthy cause. (Might be used for group work project #4 above, Ingathering, Investment, ADRA, Jerry's Kids, March of Dimes, etc.)
- 6. Help plan and participate in an ecology or conservation project (other than the personal, special project for the year), spending at least 8 hours on it.
- 7. Obtain or maintain a Good Conduct Ribbon for the current Pathfinder year.
- 8. Must be present, in Class A uniform, and pass inspection by the Conference Pathfinder Director at the time award is presented, to receive this award.

Usually only one award will be given each year. The award committee will decide if there will be more than one recipient.
